In accordance with the Illinois EPA's Environmental Justice Policy, the Office of Environmental Justice wants to provide you with information about a potential action. The Illinois EPA is sending this letter to notify you of an application received by the Bureau of Land (BOL).

The Illinois EPA has received an application for a Transfer Station Permit Log No 2024-126 for Greenway Transfer Station located at 2100 S Kilbourn Avenue in Chicago. The application requests a permit modification to maintain compliance with Section 22.38 of the Environmental Protection Act, which states, "ensure that no less than 40% of the total general construction or demolition debris (GCDD) received at the facility on a rolling 12-month average basis is recyclable general construction or demolition debris as defined in subsection (c)." The permit is issued subject to the development, operating and reporting requirements for Solid Waste Facilities in 35 IAC, Part 807 regulations.

The application is currently under review by the BOL.
